# ACCURATELY CODING E-FILINGS

Avoid the "Miscellaneous Document" Code!

### Codes for Motions

- When e-filing a motion, use a motion-specific code, <u>NOT</u> the "Miscellaneous Document" code
  - There are codes for almost every motion, including:
    - Motion for Default Judgment
    - Motion to Compel Discovery
    - Motion for Show Cause
    - Motion for Summary Disposition
    - Motion to Adjourn
    - Plus several others...

## Codes for Responses

When e-filing a response to a motion, use "Answer/Response to Motion"

#### Accurate Codes Matter

- Filings are listed in the Court's register of actions (Odyssey) using the filer's code
- Judges and Court Staff have a difficult time locating your motions and responses when they are filed as miscellaneous documents, especially without the availability of Judge's copies of motions/responses
