Potential Penalties for Noncompliance

Civil and criminal penalties are available for any person violating the reporting obligations

o Focus is expected to be on "senior officers", but the rule is written broadly to cover "any person" who violates the reporting obligations

Up to Two Years in jail and/or fines of \$500 per day up to \$10,000 for:

Willfully providing false or fraudulent information or willfully failing to report complete or updated information.







The Judicial Candidate Evaluation Committee of the Detroit Bar Association has completed its rating of participating judicial candidates officially running for open seats in the courts of Wayne County for the 2024 election cycle. The Committee is comprised of 33 attorneys from the Detroit Metropolitan area who evaluated the fitness of each candidate for judicial office based upon the candidate's legal ability (scholarship, analysis, judgment, clarity of expression), trial experience, integrity, honesty, judicial temperament, and reputation, without regard to party affiliation, race or creed. Ratings are given after review of the candidate's completed questionnaire and/or an in-person interview conducted with an Interview Panel of the Committee. The ratings refer only to a candidate's qualifications for the position of judge in the court that the candidate is seeking, and do not in any way refer to a candidate's qualifications
